

Visual T'filah Instructions

- The decision to use Visual T'filah should be made at least 6 months prior to B'nai Mitzvah ceremony. The Tutor and Rabbi should be informed as soon as possible.
- TAS/HJC currently owns the Friday Evening and Shabbat morning “deck” of Visual T'filah slides in Powerpoint. In addition, a Minchah/Havdallah deck has also been developed and is available.
- The “deck” includes a myriad of possibilities, so the family must choose what slides to use with the guidance of rabbi/tutor/mentor (someone who knows the liturgy).
- Once the slides are chosen, the text will appear in white on black or black on white. Background images can be added. Background images must be appropriate, as determined by the Rabbi or RPC. *Images of the B'nai Mitzvah child should appear on no more than one or two slides.*
- Slides with English readings may have to be individually prepared.
- Size of Hebrew, translation, and transliteration is adjustable.
- The Tech committee must be informed so that a rehearsal can be scheduled to ensure the technology is properly set up and functional (as it will be used during the Bar/Bat Mitzvah service).
