When I was in middle school, I was diagnosed with autism. Friendships and relationships have always been difficult for me. I find that the prayer “May the door to this synagogue” speaks to my struggle to be a true part of the Jewish community.

I am thrilled to be able to celebrate my Bar Mitzvah and be called to the Torah on March 2nd with Rabbi Ruskin and the congregation.
